

Prime Therapeutics (Prime) is trusted by Blue Cross to manage the pharmacy benefits within the Allianz medical plans. As a reminder, always show your current ID card to both your pharmacy and medical providers to ensure claims can be processed accurately and timely. Please continue reading to learn more about your prescription drug benefit.

Prescription Drug List: KeyRx

Your plan uses the KeyRx Drug list (also called the formulary, or list of covered drugs). If your medications are not on the KeyRx drug list, they are not covered by your plan. Refer to the information on the next page for more information on how to view the KeyRx drug List.

Pharmacy Network: Select Pharmacy Network

Your plan uses the Select Pharmacy Network. Refer to the information on the next page to learn to search for participating pharmacies.

Home Delivery: Amazon

If you prefer a more convenient option, you can use Amazon Home Delivery. Covered medications filled through Amazon Pharmacy are shipped to your home free of charge. If you are taking a maintenance (or long-term) medicine, using Home Delivery through Amazon could save time and money on your overall pharmacy costs. Specialty Prescriptions

Specialty medicines for complex illnesses (like multiple sclerosis or hemophilia) generally cost more and require extra support. All Allianz medical plans require you to use a pharmacy in the specialty pharmacy network. If you use a manufacturer coupon, only the amount you pay out-of-pocket for specialty drugs will be applied to your deductible/out-of-pocket maximum/limits. Refer to the information on the next page to learn more about the specialty pharmacy for each medical plan option.

Utilization Management Programs

All Allianz medical plans include utilization management programs which help to ensure medications are used safely and cost effectively. These programs only apply to certain drugs and include prior authorization, step therapy and dispensing limits. Drugs that fall into one of these programs are listed on your KeyRx Drug List.

- **Prior authorization:** The prior authorization program is designed to encourage safe, cost-effective medicine use. Under this program, your doctor will need to get an approval from Blue Cross for certain drugs to be covered.
- **Step therapy:** The step therapy program is used to encourage safe and cost-effective medicine use. Under this program, a “step” approach is required to receive coverage for certain high-cost medicines. This means that a medicine will not be covered unless you try another lower-cost medicine first.
- **Dispensing limits:** Dispensing limits (also called quantity limits) may be applied on select medicines. These limits help promote drug safety and help reduce waste and overuse. Limits may involve the amount of covered medicine per prescription or the amount of covered medicine in a given time period. If your doctor prescribes an amount that is more than the dispensing limit, they may request a dispensing limit authorization from Blue Cross for approval consideration.

Remember: Treatment decisions are always between you and your doctor. Coverage is always subject to the exclusions and limitations noted in your plan materials. See your plan materials for details.

Preventive Drug Coverage – Enhanced and Standard Plans Only

The Standard and Enhanced Plans include a preventive drug list (VBBD), which provides plan coverage before deductible for preventive drugs included on the KeyRx Preventive Drug List. Refer to the information on the next page to learn how to access the Preventive Drug List.
